Temporary Closure of School Street, Drayton Lane and East Street

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: School Street (10th November 2025 - 19th November 2025) - from the junction with Midelnay Road, northwards for a distance of 467 metres; Drayton Lane (3rd November 2025 - 5th November 2025) - from the junction with School Street, westwards for a distance of 119 metres and East Street (5th November 2025 - 7th November 2025) - from the junction with North Street, eastwards for a distance of 210 metres. A total distance of 796 metres. This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out phased sewer lining infiltration reduction works.

The Order becomes effective on 29th October 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 3rd November 2025 and last until 19th November 2025 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 15 days.
