(Temporary Traffic Restrictions)
Order 2025

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary traffic restrictions as specified in the Schedules below. This Order will come into operation on the 5th day of November 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months. The Works are expected to commence on the 16th day of November 2025 and last for one day (between 0800 hours and 1700 hours) to enable Sunbelt Rentals working on behalf of Openreach safe access to carry out pole replacement works. Schedule 1
Temporary One-Way

A39 Bath Road, Bridgwater(southbound) - From its junction with Branksome Avenue in a south westerly direction to the Cross Rifles Roundabout

Schedule 2
Temporary Banned Right Turn

Rosebery Avenue, Bridgwater - From Roseberry Avenue onto the A39 Bath Road

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
