Notice is hereby given that on Friday the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 2025 Somerset Council made the above order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised in the Bridgwater Mercury on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 2025 and in the Mid Somerset Series on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 2025 to introduce a 40mph speed limit on the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order. The Order comes into effect on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 2025. A copy of the Order may be inspected online at [www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO](http://www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO). If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act), or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
