**Temporary Closure of Vicarage Street, St Margarets Road, Queen Street,
Farm Street and Church Street**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Vicarage Street (05th January 2026 - 16th January 2026) - from the junction with Yeovil Road to the junction with St Margarets Road; St Margarets Road (19th January 2026 - 30th January 2026) - from the junction with Head Street to the junction with Farm Street; Queen Street (21st January 2026 - 30th January 2026) - from the junction with Farm Street to the junction with Little Trumps; Farm Street (02nd February 2026 - 06th February 2026) - from the junction with Queen Street, eastwards for 297 metres and Church Street (02nd February 2026 - 13th February 2026) - from the junction with St Margarets Road, north-westwards for 200 metres. A total distance of 1,789 metres. This Order will enable Wessex Internet to carry out phased fibre cabling works.

The Order becomes effective on 31st December 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 5th January 2026 and last until 13th February 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 36 days.
