Temporary Closure of Newman Street

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Newman Street - from 655 metres south-east of the junction with Kings Road, southwards for a total distance of 36 metres. This Order will enable Bristol Water to carry out new connection works.

The Order becomes effective on 3rd December 2025 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 9th December 2025 and last until 11th December 2025 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 3 days. There is no alternative route for this closure.
