(Temporary Prohibition of Parking)
Order 2025

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of parking as specified in the Schedule below. This Order will come into operation on the 14th day of January 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The restriction is expected to commence on the 19th day of January 2026 until the 21st day of January 2026 (between 20:00 hours and 05:00 hours). The restriction is in place to alleviate traffic congestion during the Kiely Bros works for Somerset Council on Draycott Road, Cheddar. Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles.
