Temporary Closure of Foghamshire Lane To Gare Hill, Lane To The Thicket and Gare Hill Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Foghamshire Lane To Gare Hill (2nd February 2026 - 27th March 2026) - from the junction with Bunns Lane, south-eastwards for 2630 metres; Lane To The Thicket (9th February 2026 - 20th February 2026)- from the junction with Gare Hill Lane, for its entirety and Gare Hill Lane (9th February 2026 - 20th February 2026)- from the junction with Lane To The Thicket, northwards for 114 metres. A total distance of 2849 metres. This Order will enable Bristol Water to carry out phased water main renovation works.

The Order becomes effective on 28th January 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 2nd February 2026 and last until 27th March 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 54 days.
