Temporary Closure of Cumhill Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Cumhill Lane - from 35 metres north-west of the junction with Weir Lane, westwards for a total distance of 112 metres. This Order will enable Doocey Ltd to carry out piling and reconductoring works on behalf of National Grid.

The Order becomes effective on 28th January 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 3rd February 2026 and last until 3rd February 2026 between the hours of 07:00 - 18:00 for a total of 11 hours.
