**Temporary Closure of Old Frome Road To Underhill, Long Hill, Bath Road and
Kilver Street**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, propose to make an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Old Frome Road To Underhill - from the junction with Underhill, southwards incorporating Long Hill, Bath Road and Kilver Street, to the junction with Charlton Road. A total distance of 6,462 metres. This Order will enable Kiely Bros to carry out pre-surface dressing patching works on behalf of Somerset Highways. Solid diamond symbolization will be used on the diversion route and will not clash with any other Kiely Bros works within the area.

The Order becomes effective on 4th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 11th February 2026 and last until 19th February 2026 between the hours of 19:00 - 06:00 for a total of 8 nights.
