Temporary Closure of Crooked Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, propose to make an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Crooked Lane - from the junction with Straight Lane, southwards for a total distance of 69 metres. This Order will enable Kier to carry out drainage works on behalf of Somerset Highways.

The Order becomes effective on 4th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 9th February 2026 and last until 20th February 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 12 days.
