Temporary Closure of Ham Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Ham Hill - from 89 metres south-east of the junction with Stawley Road, south-eastwards for a total distance of 516 metres. This Order will enable Keir to carry out drainage works on behalf of Somerset Highways.

The Order becomes effective on 14th January 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 19th January 2026 and last until 23rd January 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 5 days.
