Temporary Closure of Ham Hill Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Ham Hill Road - from 110 metres south-east of the junction with Woodhouse Lane, south- eastwards for a total distance of 200 metres. This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out trial hole and stop tap works.

The Order becomes effective on 28th January 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 2nd February 2026 and last until 6th February 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 5 days.
