**ORDER 2024**

Notice is hereby given that on Friday the 23rd day of January 2026 Somerset Council made the above order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 16th day of July 2024 to introduce a 30mph speed limit on the length of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order. If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act), or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
