**(7.5 Tonne Weight Limit) (Except or Access)**  
**Order 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset Council proposes to make the above Order in exercise of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to impose a 7.5 tonne weight limit except for access on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice. There will be an exemption in the order for emergency services, vehicles being used in connection with any building operation, demolition in or adjacent to that road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity. Access for vehicles of any class or description, to any premises or land situated on or adjacent to any such lengths of road, or any other premises or land accessible for vehicles of that class or description from, and only from any such length of road, for the picking up or setting down of passengers, or for loading onto or, unloading from the vehicle in any such length of road. The provisions of any other orders are hereby revoked but only as far as they are affected by the restrictions in this Order. A copy of the draft Order, the maps showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected online at [www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO](http://www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO). Any person wishing to make representations or to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their representations or objection and state the grounds on which it is made to Somerset Council, Traffic Management, B2 West, County Hall, Taunton TA1 4DY or via email to [TROinbox@somerset.gov.uk](mailto:TROinbox@somerset.gov.uk) quoting Reference No. ET16122025 and received no later than 21 days from the publication of this notice. The names and addresses of anyone writing in may be made available for public inspection and will be included in a report that may be published on the Somerset Council website, unless the individuals concerned state, in writing, their objection to their names and addresses being made so available or being included in the publication.

**Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Order**

- a) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- b) for preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road, or
- c) for preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.
