Temporary Closure of Rudge Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Rudge Lane - from 641 metres north-east the junction with Rudge Lane To Marsh Road, north-eastwards for a total distance of 20 metres. This Order will enable Bristol Water to replace a stop tap. The Order becomes effective on 4th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 10th February 2026 and last until 12th February 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 3 days.
