

**Somerset Council**

**Temporary Closure of Critchill Road**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Critchill Road - from the junction with Oakfield Road to the junction with Whitewell Road. A total distance of 658 metres. This Order will enable Kiely Bros to carry out pre-surface dressing patching works on behalf of Somerset Highways. Solid diamond symbolization will be used on the diversion route and will not clash with any other Kiely Bros works within the area.

The Order becomes effective on 11th March 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 19th March 2026 and last until 21st March 2026 between the hours of 07:00 - 19:00 for a total of 3 days.
