

**Somerset Council
Parish of Lympsham**

Temporary Closure of Rectory Way, Lympsham Road and West Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Rectory Way - from 67 metres north-west of the junction with Church Road, north-westwards for 424 metres; Lympsham Road - from 52 metres west of the junction with Bridgwater Road, south-westwards for 207 metres and West Road - from 36 metres south-west of the junction with South Road, southwards for 59 metres. A total distance of 690 metres. This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out phased sewer rehabilitation works (as and when signed on site).

The Order becomes effective on 11th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 16th February 2026 and last until 20th February 2026 between the hours of 07:00 - 22:00 for a total of 5 days.
