Temporary Closure of Pear Ash Lane

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Pear Ash Lane - from 131 metres north-east of the junction with Farthings, eastwards for a total distance of 142 metres. This Order will enable Huddwell Fibre Systems Ltd to replace a pole on behalf of Openreach.

The Order becomes effective on 11th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 18th February 2026 and last until 20th February 2026 between the hours of 08:00 - 17:30 for a total of 3 days.
