Temporary Closure of Hurst

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Hurst - from 98 metres south of the junction with Pitway Hill, southwards for a total distance of 274 metres. This Order will enable Openreach to carry out pole testing works.

The Order becomes effective on 25th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 4th March 2026 and last until 4th March 2026 between the hours of 09:30 - 15:30 for a total of 6 hours.
