

**Somerset Council
Patwell Street, Bruton
in the Parish of Bruton
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions)
Order 2026**

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary traffic restrictions as detailed in the Schedules below. This Order will come into operation on the 25th day of February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The Works are expected to commence on the 5th day of March 2026 for one day (between 19:00 hours and 23:30 hours) to enable Wessex Water to carry out interim to permanent reinstatement works. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs. A copy of the draft Traffic Regulation Order and the associated plans can be examined at www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO. **Schedule 1
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Patwell Street, Bruton - From a point 8 metres east of the junction with the A359 High Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 46 metres

**Schedule 2
Temporary Suspension of One Way**

Patwell Street, Bruton - From a point 55 metres east of the junction with the A359 High Street to the junctions with Silver Street and Station Road

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
