Temporary Closure of Cutcombe Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Cutcombe Hill - from the junction with Steart Lane, south-eastwards for a total distance of 531 metres. This Order will enable Kier to carry out remedial earthworks on behalf of Somerset Highways.

The Order becomes effective on 4th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 09th February 2026 and last until 27th February 2026 between the hours of 19:00 - 07:00 for a total of 18 nights.
