Temporary Closure of Asham Lane and Ham Road

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Asham Lane (24th February 2026) - from the junction with Ham Road, north-eastwards for 42 metres. Ham Road (25th February 2026 - 26th February 2026) - from 268 metres north-westwards of the junction with Cob Castle, westwards for 149 metres. A total distance of 191 metres. This Order will enable Arboricare Ltd to carry out phased tree trimming and removal works on behalf of Somerset Highways. The Order becomes effective on 18th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 24th February 2026 and last until 26th February 2026 between the hours of 08:00 - 16:00 for a total of 3 days.
