Parishes of Huish Champflower, Old Cleeve and Brompton Regis Temporary Closure of Beulah Chapel To Robbery Gate

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Beulah Chapel To Robbery Gate - from the junction with Beulah Chapel To Withiel Hill, south- westwards for a total distance of 1578 metres. This Order will enable Dunmore SW to lay duct and install new boxes on behalf of Openreach.

The Order becomes effective on 18th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 23rd February 2026 and last until 15th March 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 21 days.
