Temporary Closure of Haines Hill

Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, propose to make an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along: Haines Hill - from 155 metres east of the junction with Trull Road, eastwards for a total distance of 42 metres. This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out new connection works.

The Order becomes effective on 25th February 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months. The works are expected to commence on 2nd March 2026 and last until 6th March 2026 between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59 for a total of 5 days.
